## Corporate sector is sold out



THE corporate sector of the Airnorth Kimberley Moon Experience is already a sell-out for this year's event on May 17. The 550 exclusive **Kimberley Fine Diamonds Corporate Circle** tickets priced at \$390 each sold out in just four weeks.

Organisers are already talking about extending the lavish dining segment of the concert for 2009. This year the Moon Experience will be the grand final to the two-week Argyle Diamonds Ord Valley Muster.

Aussie rock legend Jimmy Barnes and his two daughters Mahalia and Elly-May headline this year's entertainment. Organising committee chairman Murray Coates said the event was now firmly part of WA's social calendar.

"We're very pleased that demand is so strong for what has become one of the State's major corporate events," said Mr Coates. "The concert is one-of-a-kind, offering a spectacular setting on the banks of the Ord River, world class entertainment, sophisticated locally produced food, and a fantastic party atmosphere.

"We're thrilled it's such a winner with the corporate market." So high was demand that organisers released additional tickets in a ballot system.

General admission tickets are also selling fast, with more than 2,500 people of all ages expected to enjoy the concert picnic-style. This year there will be a new master of ceremonies in the person of country and western singer Adam Harvey.

A current star of Channel 7 hit television show *It Takes Two*, Adam is also the winner of

seven Golden Guitar awards for his popular albums and songs. Adam will be joined by a host of quality entertainers including the Australian Army Band – Darwin, popular Perth party band Peace Love and All That Stuff featuring Tod Johnston and talented Kimberley musicians and entertainers.

General admission tickets are still available for the Moon Experience and ticket prices are \$75 for adults, \$25 for children five to 15 years, \$160 for families of two adults and three children under 15 years. Tickets for the Airnorth Kimberley Moon Experience are available from Travelworld Kununurra, Kununurra Newsagency and **Kimberley Fine Diamonds** and the Kununurra Visitor Centre.
