Miss World Australia 2006 Sponsorship

Throughout 2006/07 Kimberley Fine Diamonds, as the major sponsor of Miss World Australia 2006, Sabrina Houssami, showcased the precious and rare gems of Australia's far north east to the world. Sabrina Houssami wore a beautifully crafted priceless collection of KFD jewellery during her Miss World 2006 grand finale appearance in Poland, an event which was televised to a viewing audience of more than two billion across the globe.

As one of the most successful Miss World entrants in the country's history, Sabrina returned to Australia crowned Miss World Asia Pacific and second runner-up in the entire pageant.

She has since gone on to showcase Kimberley Fine Diamond jewellery at A-list events across the country, including the 2006 Melbourne Cup, the Grand Summer Sydney Bridal Expo, Jeans for Genes Day, and in her role as ambassador of the 2007 Grand Prix.

With children's charity work being Sabrina's first love, Kimberley Fine Diamonds was proud in December 2006 to host her visit to Kununurra where she met with local indigenous children through the Save the Children Fund.

Sabrina's visit to the region was anticipated and warmly welcomed on par with royalty. The excitement was palpable – the town and local press had been talking about her impending visit for weeks - and the dazzling Aussie jewel did not disappoint. At the Kununurra football oval Sabrina met with children of indigenous communities and kept them enthralled with exciting tales of adventure as part of the Save the Children Fund family fun night. She then went on to be the belle of the ball at the Kimberley Fine Diamonds Christmas soiree where she thanked her proud sponsor for helping her to shine so brightly.



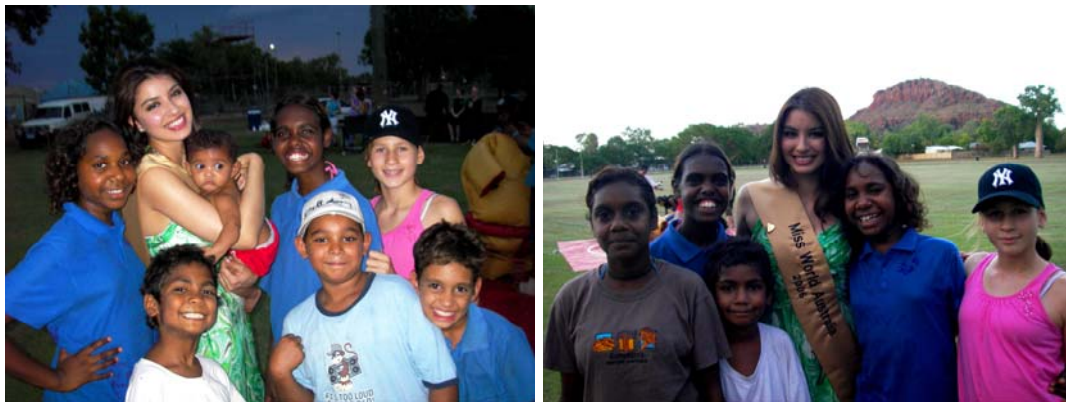

Since being crowned Miss World Asia Pacific, Sabrina has gone on to continue her charity work, recently joining Father Chris Riley from Youth Off The Streets, visiting orphanages in East Timor where work is underway to provide the underprivileged youngsters with as many resources as possible – everything from fresh water systems to food and clothing.

Kimberley Fine Diamonds created amazing pieces of fine jewellery for Sabrina – including the aptly named *Crowning Collection* featuring a matched-set of four extremely rare pink diamonds – which made the exclusive *IT List* in the *Sunday Telegraph* Valentine's Day gift guide. Not since the pink diamond brooch fashioned by Cartier for Queen Elizabeth II, has a pink diamond collection had such majestic intrigue.



The *Crowning Collection* (above) comprises a white gold necklace studded with diamonds featuring an extremely rare pink diamond set at the centre of a heart, with matching bracelet, earrings, and two amazing dress rings. The collection comprises more than 18 carats of brilliant white diamonds and two carats of the world's rarest pink diamonds.

Sabrina is never without Kimberley sparkle with a dazzling array of brilliant white, champagne, and pink diamond jewellery in her extended collection.

Kimberley Fine Diamonds was last year the first fine jeweller to cast pendants in the shaped of the Miss World Australia logo. The delicate 18 ct gold diamond studded pendants were created for all Miss World Australia state winners in appreciation of their generous charity work.

The Kimberley Fine Diamonds and Miss World Australia sponsorship continues in 2007 forging ahead under the Miss World motto of 'beauty with a purpose'.
